- 2. All correspondence and comments to or from FWS and the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, dated May 1, 2020 to the present, related to the Clean Water Act analysis requirements, including but not limited to a 404(b)(1) analysis, compensatory mitigation plan, and State of Alaska 401 certification process and decision.
- 3. All documents pertaining to any meetings the FWS attended with the Corps of Engineers occurring May 1, 2020 to the present, regarding the Clean Water Act analysis requirements for the proposed Pebble project, including but not limited to a 404(b)(1) analysis and the compensatory mitigation plan.
- 4. All FWS draft comments and related internal correspondence related to any of the above.
