Below is what I found on the Minnesota DNR Trapping and Furbearers website

- There is a downloadable PDF titled *Minnesota Hunting and Trapping Regulations* (effective July 2020 – June 30, 2021) and this includes guidance for lynx in “Releasing protected species” section on p. 52, “Lynx Management Zone regulations” on pp. 53-54, and “Reporting incidentally taken furbearers” on p. 54.
