(Cantwell) Question 2: The North Cascades Grizzly Bear Restoration Plan process, led by the National

Park Service and the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, was started in 2015 under President Obama and Secretary Sally Jewell. The National Park Service and the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service continued through the environmental review process until the Trump abruptly terminated the Final Environmental Impact Statement (FEIS) in July 2020. A Record of Decision was never issued. Can you commit to resuming the FEIS and issuing a Record of Decision on the North Cascades Grizzly Bear Restoration Plan?

RESPONSE: If confirmed, I will rely on the expertise of my legal and policy team to brief me on the previous Administration's termination of the Final Environmental Impact Statement (FEIS) and best steps forward for the North Cascades Grizzly Bear Restoration Plan. I am committed to working with you on this important issue
