Looks ok to me, except for one phrasing that I'm sure has been thoroughly discussed and vetted. I know we want to be sensitive to our partners and the fact that we have made considerable conservation progress in GYE and NCDE.

The wording that grizzlies in NCDE and GYE "are biologically recovered" seems a little strong and might be predecisional. There's probably a lot behind the selection of that wording. If there's not, saying something less definitive - "we recognize that NCDE and GYE populations have realized significant conservation gains by addressing threats to grizzly bears in those areas".
