Title Species Status Assessment for the Grizzly Bear in the Lower-48 States

Description This species status assessment (SSA) documents the results of our comprehensive review of the life history, ecology, threats, and viability for the grizzly bear (*Ursus arctos horribilis*) in the conterminous (lower-48) United States (hereafter, grizzly bear). The grizzly bear is listed as threatened under the Endangered Species Act (Act) in the lower-48 States (40 FR 31734, July 28, 1975), and this listed entity is the subject of this SSA report. As such, unless specified otherwise, we use the term "species" to refer to the listed entity and the term "ecosystem" to refer to the populations of this listed entity. This SSA report is intended to provide the best available biological information to inform the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service's (Service's) decisions for the grizzly bear under the Act, including a 5-year status review and any additional actions, as needed.
