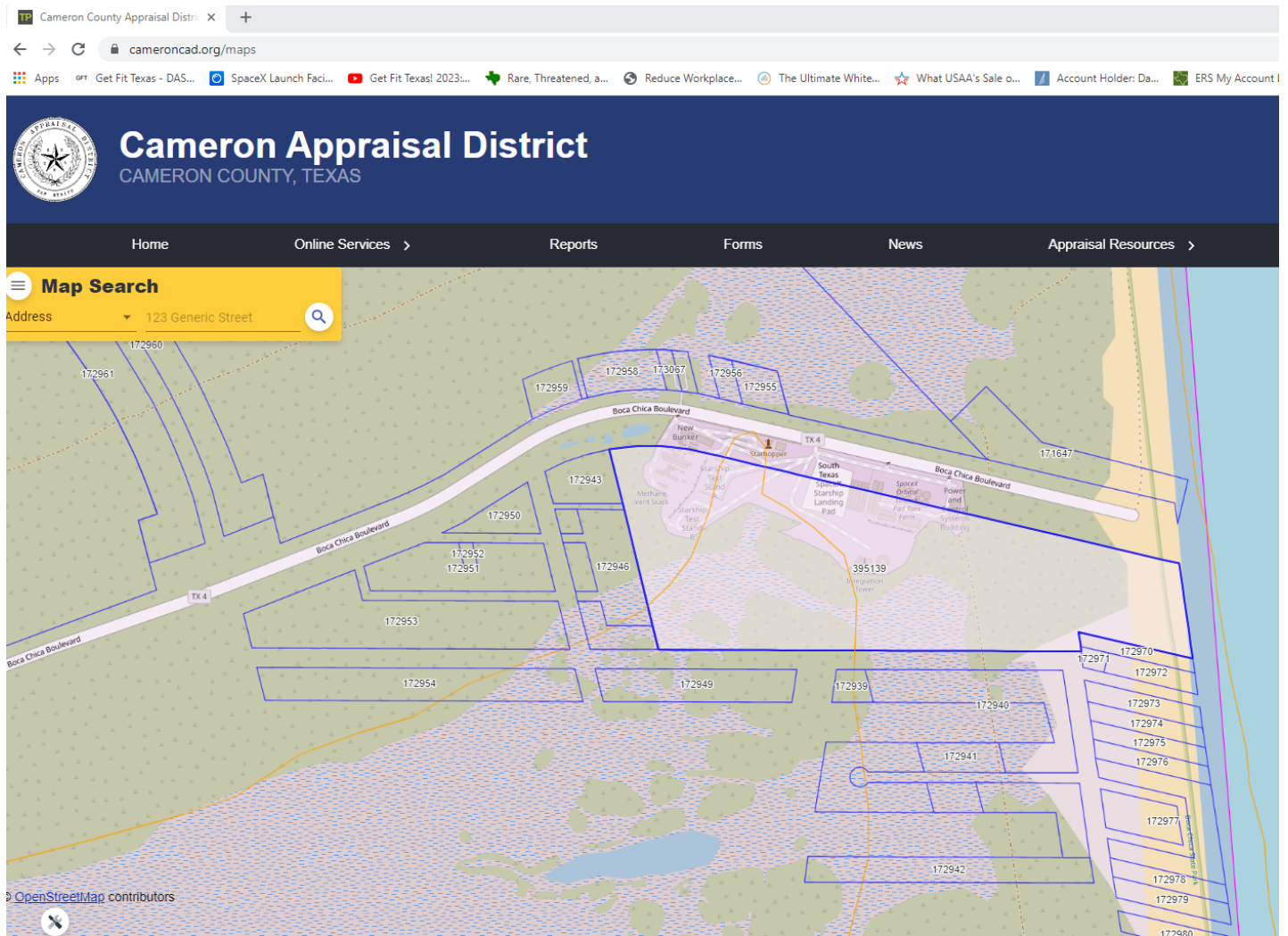

Thank you. The Cameron Co CAD site is working again. I must have just caught it on a day the map was offline. If you click on the # it shows you the ownership info. Dog Leg Park is SpaceX and there are a couple other names as well. The boundaries are notoriously incorrect, but it is still very helpful. The areas with no #s were intended to be roads to all the lots and anyone can still legally drive down them. We intended to have the roads vacated at one point, and the ownership generally goes to the surrounding owners, so that TPWD would have authority to limit vehicle access, but it has not been done. It would have been easy enough before SpaceX. Now we probably couldn't do it. I think it would require the County, but I don't know the process.

A site visit was conducted by Stephanie Bilodeau (USFWS) and Willy Cupit (TPWD) in the area south of the SpaceX launch pad on 10 February 2023.

Richard Moore (Local Outdoor Reporter) was also present for the site visit.

No dead or injured wildlife were found.

Photos from the site visit along with gps coordinates can be found in the attached files.

The debris field consisted primarily of rocks that were lining a detention pond at the launch site. The size of these rocks ranged from 1 to 4+ inches.
