

Questions:

1. When is the first RD meeting? ~~Has the first one been cancelled, with the~~We recommend the first meeting be changed to the being the week of May 17 ~~to allow adequate time to complete a draft of the species report. We also recommend that if a second RD meeting is needed it be separated from the first meeting by enough time to allow for any follow-up work (e.g., 1 month rather than 1 week).~~²
2. When can we expect the model outputs? (by model type, effort)

What the Species Lead Team would like to see in a draft report by April 1:

- One consolidated document
 - The document should include clarification on how the chapter authors addressed the concerns of reviewers
 - For each threat chapter the draft document should contain:
 - What has changed from 2010
 - Information from the general data call
 - Spatial Data
 - Risk/disturbance (direct footprint)
 - Conservation Efforts
 - CED data for that particular threat
 - NRCS data ~~(if applicable)~~
 - ~~FIAT report (if applicable)~~
 - Final BLM/FS allocation data
 - Any new literature on the threat
 - All articles and reference materials cited in the various chapters of the species report should be stored in the RefWorks database.
 - All pdf documents of articles and reference materials should be uploaded to the References and Citations file on SharePoint and using the naming convention in the SOP.
 - Direction on whether or not a Columbia Basin DPS analysis needs to be part of the species report; and species-specific criteria we should use to analyze discreteness and significance for this population (e.g., using the DPS framework document as a starting point).

- FIAT report (if applicable) – ~~we likely will not have the FIAT step-down assessments and associated spatial data for the fire, invasives, and conifer chapters in time for authors to include in their analysis by April 1;~~ propose that this should be completed by authors and provided to SLT by mid-April.
