Beauty and the Beak: by Deborah Lee Rose and Janie Veltkamp

Bald eagles are a true migratory bird success story. Brought back from near extinction in the U.S. lower 48 states, they now migrate and nest in increasing numbers across the country, and in Canada and northern Mexico. Millions of people of all ages can now spot bald eagles soaring majestically in the wild or watch them tenderly feeding their young via live-streaming eagle cams. Yet news reports remind us this migratory species, the U.S. national symbol, still faces threats from lead poisoning, illegal poaching, and collision with human technology like power lines and wind turbines. One story of hope—about a bald eagle named Beauty who was shot in the beak, rescued, and given a 3D-printed prosthetic beak—captures the power of bald eagles as environmental educators, and the potential of STEM in pioneering prosthetics for injured animals and people.
