Self-led Field Trips

Advance reservations are requested for all educational groups visiting Bosque del Apache National Wildlife Refuge. Reservations allow staff to arrange logistics and avoid conflicts with other groups and resource management. Group leaders must fill out the "Educational Visit Request" section.

Advance reservations are required for all educational groups seeking to visit Bosque del Apache National Wildlife Refuge without paying a fee. A fee waiver may be issued for educational groups. School group leaders must fill out the "Fee Waiver Application" section to explain what they hope to learn from their visit and how it fits into their curriculum objectives.

The Friends of Bosque del Apache National Wildlife Refuge may offer a bus scholarship to defray some of the travel costs to visit the refuge, depending on the availability of funds and the compatibility of the visit with the Friends mission. If you are seeking reimbursement for your field trip to the refuge, please also complete the "Bus Scholarship Application" section.

Bus Scholarship Application

Scholarships are based on the miles traveled at \$0.50/mile, and driver costs at \$8.00/hour for the time to travel (at 55mph) plus a 4-hour allotment for time on site. For schools outside of Socorro County, the scholarship will be 75% of this calculation per bus, with a maximum of \$250 per school per field trip.

For example, 1 bus coming from Los Alamos would travel 384 miles and spend 11 hours traveling and on site. Their scholarship calculation would be:

75%[(\$0.50/mile x # miles)+(\$8.00/hour x # hours traveling and on site)]

0.75[(0.50x384)+(8x11)]=210

If they brought 2 buses, they would only receive the maximum scholarship of \$250.
