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I think we're getting there.

Figures 2 & 7: I would like to see about combining these figures. It seems kind of redundant to have two figures that show the BMUs. I like that the new Figure 2 shows the land manager but I think it is sufficient to show National Park lands versus Forest Service lands. What about splitting the legend into two main categories: BMUs and BMAs. Then creating two subcategories for BMUs for National Park lands (yellow) and National Forest lands (green). All BMAs would be National Forest lands (lighter green?). I like the color selections you currently use in Figure 2 but I don't think we need to show individual parks and forests for this one.

Figure 6: I would like to add back in the major cities, such as Cody, Jackson, etc. I don't think it does anything to have GTNP in grey and I still haven't heard back from Dave on this issue. We also need to change the legend to read 'National Park lands'.

New figure: I think we need to add the DMA boundary. The legend also needs to be changed to 'National Park lands'. I'm trying to decide if this figure is too redundant with the current figure 1, although I like showing individual forests somewhere. I don't think we need the roads on this one if it gets too busy once the DMA is added.
