o The estimated population inside the park, “approximately 150 with home ranges wholly or partially in the park” (www.nps.gov/yell/learn/nature/grizzlybear.htm<<http://www.nps.gov/yell/learn/nature/grizzlybear.htm>>) means that current bear numbers in the park are less than or barely exceed numbers estimated in 1975 (126-312 “restricted largely to the confines of Yellowstone National Park and some surrounding areas”).
