I would think there needs to be a written (?) directive coming from the Supervisors/Superintendents to inform folks in each Forest and Park unit that this mandate to revamp developed sites has been approved by the YES committee as a high priority and that their cooperation will be needed. You're right in that before we can begin the GIS portion, we will need to discuss our goals and objectives.
