I just had a conference call with Deputy Regional Forester et al. He will be meeting with WO leadership team next week. They will discuss YES/Conservation Strategy/delisting issues. Central to this is understanding the alternatives in CS Appendix C. Consequently, we were asked to put a briefing paper together on this to frame that discussion and others to follow. Ultimately, this would lead to the FS taking a position on the best alternative and the associated issues.

Is preparing a briefing paper worthwhile now in the sense that the alternatives are still changing? We don't want to address material if it will soon be out of date. But if we don't frame this for FS managers, they will really struggle with understanding the choices and the issues and with following through to take a position.

Does this seem reasonable?

If you learn about changes to the alternatives, could you let us know?- keep us in the loop such that the discussions, paper preparation and potential. FS summary statement are relevant. Thanks.
