I assume IGBST will document all grizzly bear mortalities (including location specific information and cause of death) that occur within the Yellowstone **Distinct Population Segment (DPS)**. Location specific information will be required to determine whether or not mortalities occur within the **Demographic Monitoring Area (DMA)**.

So yes, all mortalities inside and outside the PCA will be documented along with cause of death and location.
