Actually as I go thru, I don't have many since I don't have the sensitive species language yet. Will send that to you as soon as I get it.

And for some reason I can't seem to change the font color so I capitalized my addition to the text.

\*Expansion (in capacity and acreage) of existing administrative sites is exempt from mitigation if such developments are deemed necessary for enhancement of public land management and other viable alternatives are not available. Temporary construction of work camps for highway construction or other major maintenance projects AND FOR EMERGENCY RESPONSE (SUCH AS FIRE) are exempt from human capacity mitigation if other viable alternatives are not available. Food storage structures and management must be in place and all other factors resulting in potential detrimental impacts to grizzly bears will be mitigated as identified for other developed sites.

Outside the PCA, secure habitat is measured and reported biennially (even numbered years) for each bear analysis unit (BAU, see Figure 7). Changes in configuration and status of motorized routes are submitted each year to the Grizzly Bear Habitat Database Coordinator by representatives from each National Forest and National Park in the ecosystem. FOR THIS SECTION, WE SAY SECURE HABITAT IS MEASURED BIENNIALY AND CHANGES IN MOTORIZED ROUTES EVERY YEAR. I WOULD PREFER THESE BE CONSISTENT AND DONE BIENNIALY.

There also is one place in the discussion of the new Grizzly Bear Coordinating Committee where it says GYCC rather than YGCC

Finally, there was a comment near the end regarding signatories and I was confused by the comment since the tribes are not signatories to the CS but I do think we want them, plus local govt, on the YGCC. So not sure if that comment got resolved or not.
