Hi Jennifer,

In light of the upcoming 2-year review of developed sites, I have scrutinized the current developed sites that constitute the 1998 baseline. The attached tables contain very minor changes to the tables I last submitted in January of 2016. These should replace Tables 2 and 4 in Appendix E of the 2016 Conservation Strategy.

Note: I removed the first footnote in Table 2 indicating that this table gets precedence over pre-existing tables. Instead, I'm thinking it should be replaced with a note in the body of text that refers to all tables in Appendix E. Something like:

Tables in this appendix represent the most current baseline information available and supersedes comparable tables in the appendices of the 2007 Conservation Strategy for the Grizzly Bear in the Greater Yellowstone Area (USFWS, 2007); Forest Plan Amendment for Grizzly Bear Habitat Conservation for the Greater Yellowstone Area National Forests, Final Environmental Impact Statement (USDA Forest Service 2006a); and the 2006 Forest Plan Amendment Record of Decision (USDA Forest Service 2006b).

Also, the 3 citations should be included in the literature cited at the end of Appendix E.
