Jennifer, no we do not have footprints. This has always been a conundrum with developed sites - they have always been represented as a mere point. It may be a simple patrol cabin in the back country, or a major developed site (which may include multiple buildings) - they are all portrayed as points. In fact, when I inherited this database, there wasn't even a geometry point for many of the sites. The most complete record of developed sites exists in an Excel spreadsheet. I believe the entire concept of developed sites need to be revisited for the next review of the CS.
