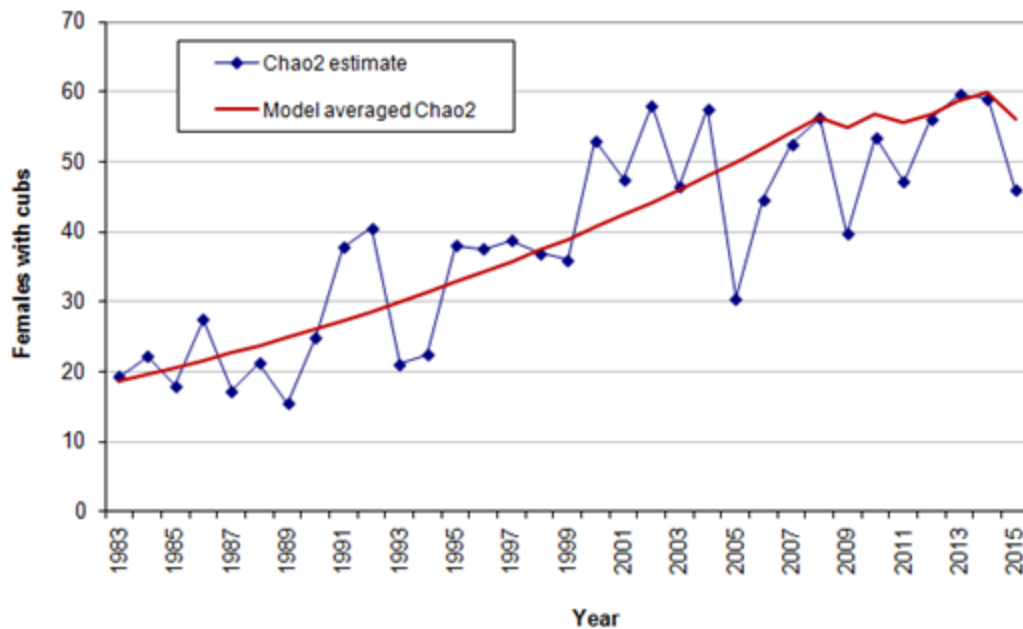

One thing we will be able to clear up on Tuesday is the final figure that depicts the model averaged chao2 females with cubs of the year estimate (versus raw counts or annual chao2). This graph demonstrates that we have been above 48 fcoy since early 2000s
