Population Sub-Group Members;

The YES Steering Committee met on May 31st and reviewed our Sub-Group report and recommendations. Our Population Sub-Group asked for additional time to make clarifying edits to portions of Chapter 2 and Appendix C to clear up confusion based on mixed language relating to females with coy, cubs-of-the-year, and young (pages 6, 22, 33-35, 37-40, and 50). Sub-Group members Dan Thompson (Wyoming) and Jennifer Fortin-Noreus (USFWS) worked together with Frank VanManen (IGBST) to provide these attached edits that should improve consistency. The reviewers also substituted a different figure that represents "model averaged" number of females with cubs-of-the-year on pages 37-38. This is more representative of what is being stated in Recovery Criterion 1. Please review and provide me with your feedback by the end of this week, it should go quickly-changes are noted with track changes in both word documents.
