Some primary activities of the YGCC are:

- Provide response and recommendation in response to any listing petition.

A Biology and Monitoring Review will make recommendations as to whether the delisting should be reevaluated a petition for relisting should be made. This recommendation shall be based upon the magnitude of the threat that the deviation from the desired condition poses to the maintenance of a recovered population.

~~The YGCC has to formally agree with a recommendation from the IGBST to petition for relisting. The YGCC will consider, review and analyze any recommendations from the IGBST and my decide to make formal recommendations to the USFWS.~~

~~If the situation, after completion of the Biology and Monitoring Review, is such that some or all of the desired population and habitat conditions specified in this Conservation Strategy are not being met, and cannot be met in the opinion of the YGCC, then the YGCC will submit to the Fish and Wildlife Service a recommendation to consider petition for relisting. In the case of a vote on this issue, a simple majority is necessary.~~
