Greetings Fellow YES Members and IGBC Representatives. I wanted to provide a brief update/progress report for YES that will inform our Committee as well as provide an update for this week's IGBC meeting.

I've attached 4 documents.

The first document is a Status Report, courtesy of Brian Nesvik, Chair of the Steering Committee working on Conservation Strategy Revisions. Every agency, Tribe, or County that requested representation on the Steering Committee should be getting information on progress from your representative as well. The document entitled "Steering Committee Themes" summarizes the grouping of issues that were identified at the April YES meeting.

The YES Workplan document summarizes progress on our 2016 Action Plan. We discussed this briefly at the last YES meeting.
