Hi Frank,

Dan and I are on the YES Conservation Strategy sub-group to address habitat issues that have been raised. We have been tasked with proposing edits to the food monitoring section of Chapter 3 and would appreciate the input of the Study Team.

Two of the major issues that have been raised so far are: 1) the addition of other methods to monitor food intake (i.e., body condition and/or stable isotopes); and 2) the potential to phase out or reduce the commitment to the current monitoring of the 4 high-caloric foods. There may be additional issues that arise through public comment and peer-review, which we should have by the end of June.

Given the significance of this task, we would request that the study team hold a special 1 day meeting to edit this section as a group.
