The figures you requested redone only show the Recovery Zone as the outer boundary. I think the DMA boundary should be included in any figure we redo since that is a key part of any new proposed rule. Also, the table you requested that we redo spans the period when we are using 2 different sets of vital rates (1983-2001 and 2002-2011). My suggestion would be to redo that table for the period 2002-2014 and only assess mortality limits for known and probable mortalities occurring inside the DMA.
