Dan,

At last week's meeting we agreed to several things. The first item was that the states would provide us with their proposed revision of the demographic criteria in the recovery plan. This is the document that we built as a group as the technical team. It went out for public comment in 2013. As you recall, WY wrote a letter supporting these revisions and MT and ID did not comment. Since then, some people have wanted to change some of these criteria and so we agreed last week that the states would take a shot at revising these (even though they agreed to them or did not object to them in 2013). These criteria have to be scientifically-based and they need to go through peer review by outside scientists and public review. Attached is a WORD version of the 2013 criteria. Please make your proposed edits in this in track changes so we

can see the proposed changes and name it v2. I also attach the charge to peer reviewers that we used for the 2013 revisions. We will have a new peer review of the scientific validity of the next revision, so please keep this in mind.

The states also agreed to provide us with a draft state MOU that would detail how the states would respond with management responses should there be departures from the criteria noted above. These have to be actual regulatory actions in state regulations and policy that implement specific management actions (not IGBST reviews) in response to exceeding mortality limits.

Finally, we agreed that the demographic sections of the CS be amended to align with the above 2 documents and the actions in them. This will involve the IGBST since the application protocol will have to be revised.

So, the first issue is agreement on the state's ideas on the revisions of the RP demographic criteria, since the amendments to the demographic sections of the CS will depend on that document. Once we have agreement on that, we can proceed to the next item: the CS.
