Tim: Gary will have to comment on the accuracy of your list overall, but regarding your grizzly bear question, I note that the logic of the ruling (which I believe to be wrong) would prevent not only the Yellowstone grizzly bear delisting but also the Hawaiian green sea

turtle delisting. Parenthetically, I would note that it also would have prevented earlier delistings or reclassifications of various populations of American alligators, brown pelicans, Columbian white-tailed deer, Steller sea lions, and several foreign species.
