Attached is my best attempt to address all of your questions – my comments are in pink. The very last question reminded me that Bear Analysis Units (BAUs) for monitoring habitat outside the PCA do not appear anywhere in the CS since they were devised by Kim Barber and included only in the 2006 FPA (p. 392). I've attached a b&w figure in case you want to insert them in Chapter 1 of the CS with all of the other spatial boundary figures. I can tweak it anyway you wish.

Caption for BAU figure:

Bear Analysis Units for monitoring habitat outside the GBRZ on the national forests in the Greater Yellowstone Ecosystem. Simple hatched area is the GBRZ and Grand Teton National Park. Crosshatched BAUs are not currently evaluated, as they are considered socially unacceptable for grizzly bear occupancy in Wyoming.

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
