Ladies – for the Gallatin Forest Plan cleanup amendment, we overlooked the nuisance bear standards in the CS, but are now considering adding them. I’ve taken the language pretty much as it appears in the 2007 CS and tweaked it a bit to fit with our proposal. Basically, this means I added the words “recovery zone” along with “primary conservation area” since our Plan amendment will cover the bear regardless of legal status (listed or delisted). I’ve also removed references to the national parks, as well as references to sheep, since under our amendment proposal, the Gallatin would not have any domestic sheep grazing permitted anywhere inside the RZ/PCA. I’ve attached a doc with language that would be removed **highlighted** and language that would be added in **red**. Take a look and let me know what you think – it’s pretty minor changes. Any comments/suggestions would be much appreciated, but we are getting close to deadlines so I can’t wait too long. If you want to discuss, we could set up a conference call to do that. Thanks for your time!

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
