AUTHORITY


Under the authority of 16 U.S.C. Section 3, and Title 36, Code of Federal Regulations, Chapter 1, Parts 1-7, this Compendium of Superintendent's Orders is established for Grand Teton National Park and the John D. Rockefeller, Jr. Memorial Parkway. Regulations listed in this compendium are a requirement in addition to those listed in Parts 1-7 of Title 36 unless otherwise noted. The specific authority for this regulatory procedure is found in Sections 1.5, 1.6 and 1.7 of Title 36.

PART 1 - GENERAL PROVISIONS

Section 1.2 (d): Applicability and Scope

(d) Grizzly Bear Management: The administrative activities conducted by Grand Teton National Park and John D. Rockefeller Jr. Memorial Parkway or its agents, relative to the management and handling of grizzly bears (*Ursus arctos horribilis*) and their habitat, will be in accordance with the guidelines, procedures, and rules described in the "Final Environmental Impact Statement, Grizzly Bear Management Program" and the "Grand Teton National Park Bear Management Plan." Upon de-listing of grizzly bears from *Threatened Species Status* by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, management of grizzly bears and their habitat will be in accordance with the "Conservation Strategy for the Grizzly Bear in the Greater Yellowstone Area."
