Attached is the latest version of the letter.

In paragraph 2, 1st sentence, we are thinking of replacing w/ the following from the proposed rule: "If the State plans change from those available for comment appended to this draft Strategy, these revised State plans will be available for public comment and finalized prior to a final determination on this proposed rule. All the State and Federal agencies party to the draft 2016 Conservation Strategy will need to sign a memorandum of understanding agreeing to implement the revised 2016 Conservation Strategy prior to a final rule."

Question: When we say that these plans will be available for public comment, do the states have their own public comment process, or are we referring to our own comment process here?

In paragraph 2, last sentence, where are the Forest Service and NPS at w/ the management plans and compendia? Have they started yet and what do we know about the timing?

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
