Fellow YES Members, more context may help you prepare for Monday's meeting.

The Conservation Strategy version you received earlier today is the final Steering Committee approved version provided for dissemination. There remain a few issues to be addressed including recalibration language and wording to address the term of the Conservation Strategy.

Again, it is critical that members come having read and reviewed these materials. Be prepared to ask questions and provide input on anything you have concerns with. To the extent possible, individual agencies with multiple members on YES should coordinate ahead of time so as to represent a consistent agency perspective.

Some additional thoughts in preparation:

We will ask members to advise the Committee if there are particular issues or components of the CS that preclude you from recommending signature. You will be asked to provide a recommendation for resolution of your concern.

We will strive for finality on individual issues by the end of the meeting. As we work through this process, anticipate and be prepared for a vote on individual issues as well as on the Conservation Strategy in total.
