This serves as a second partial response to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), 5 U.S.C. § 552, request, dated January 19, 2017. In your request, you asked for:

• A copy of all documents, including reports, letters, emails, and any other written communications, between USFWS and the Eastern Collier Property Owners (ECPO), including their contractors and employees, concerning the Eastern Collier Habitat Conservation Plan, ECPO's application for an incidental take permit and the related environmental impact statement between the time period January 1, 2015, to present.

Response

We provided a partial response to you on February 1, 2017. We have located the remaining files and at this time, we are releasing a portion of the responsive records. We have located a total of twenty-nine (29) documents. Twenty-four (24) documents containing two hundred thirty-two (232) pages have been deemed releasable in full. The remaining five (5) documents (77 pages) are undergoing review. Once this review is complete, we will provide you a response concerning the remaining documents.

Conclusion

For your information, Congress excluded three discrete categories of law enforcement and national security records from the requirements of the FOIA. See 5 U.S.C. § 552(c). This response is limited to those records that are subject to the requirements of the FOIA. This is a standard notification that is given to all our requesters and should not be taken as an indication that excluded records do, or do not, exist.
