Unfortunately they did not realize this when the group came with the letter to oppose delisting. I stressed the YES meeting coming up in Cody end of April and they are planning on having someone attend (so are Arapahoe). I will keep folks up to date on any other discussions but they were very appreciative of our efforts working with the tribes over the last several years and making the point to talk with them directly. The tribal chair apologize for not seeking more answers before signing the letter that made the media, but I think for the future we'll be in good shape.
