Here is the first request for extending the comment period. My recommendation would be to extend the comment period 60 more days as they request and to deny additional hearings since we did these same two locations for hearings in 2007. I fully expect that we will get additional requests for comment period extensions given the size and complexity of the 3 documents we are asking for comment on. In 2007 we extended the comment period to 120 days.
