Assistant Director Frazer et al.:

First, thank you all for taking the time to meet with us on Friday to discuss the proposed rule to delist the GYE grizzly bear. We will be submitting our substantive comments tomorrow and hope the Service takes into consideration the information provided in those comments in making its final determination on the proposed rule.

Additionally, I know a few of us talked about a briefing that was sponsored by the House Natural Resources Committee Democrats regarding grizzlies and the ESA.
