I word/term searched the CS and the delisting order for references concerning the mandated 5 year evaluation in the conservation strategy.

* I found no specific language in the Delisting Order referencing the mandate other than the ESA requirement for monitoring all delisted and recovered species. Since the draft 2016 CS document serves as the post-delisting monitoring plan, it makes sense that the CS would have the specific requirements.

*The CS document has two references that the CS "will be evaluated by the management agencies every five years, or as necessary, allowing public comment in the updating process". Note that it did not indicate that the YES/YGCC is mandated. (page 2 and 18).

It appears that the mandate is sufficiently clear for the reader and that the "management agencies" should plan on a formal CS review at the 5 year mark.
