Hi Tamara:

Not sure why I am just hearing about this, but see attached info. A lynx that was reportedly caught by the foot in a small marten bodygrip trap but escaped from the trap. Occurred in late November. Most details you may want should be in the documents. Unlikely there will be any chance of finding DNA at this time, so we simply are going on the trapper's word that it was a lynx (not that I doubt this).


Copying Andy Edwards with 1854 Authority since it involved an 1854 tribal trapper. Nothing required here, just an FYI.
