Hi Tam, Tim Catton let me you should be informed if a lynx is trapped on the forest, so here's the scoop.

On December 30, 2013 a lynx was caught by the foot in a marten trap and was able to release itself. The trapper reported it to DNR Conservation Officer (b) (6), who works out of Hovland, MN.

The location was approximately T63N, R1E, Section 11, south of Forest Road 309 (Greenwood Lake Road), near Forest Road 309D (Twelve Lake Road).

That's all the information I have.
