OFFICER reports:

On 01-25-12 I, State Conservation Officer Mark Mathy, spoke with Matthews about the incidental take of a Lynx reported in ICR N12000053. At approximately 2:30 p.m. I met Matthews at his residence at 6610 156th St. NE Cass Lake, MN 56633. Matthews showed me the snare location and told me about the details of the incidental take of the Lynx. Details are listed below:

- Matthews found the Lynx dead in his snare on his property on the evening of Friday, January 20th 2012.
- Matthews believed the Lynx was caught in the snare sometime in the evening of Thursday, January 19th 2012 based on his experience with the decay rates of dead trapped animals.
- Matthews used a 5/64" diameter snare cable.
- Matthews placed the bottom of the snare loop approximately seven inches off the ground.
- The snare loop diameter was about six or seven inches.
- Bait wasn't placed by Matthews.
- The snare location was in a natural funnel area of high ground between two wetlands.
- Matthews placed twigs above the top of the snare to direct the animals head into the snare loop.
- The snare cable was anchored by wire connecting the snare cable to a small tree.
- The GPS location of the snare was at or near N 47 22.193, W 94 38.077 in the southeast section 17 of T145N R31W, Cass County.
- Matthews turned the Lynx in to LLCO Chief Mitchell first thing in the morning on Monday, January 23rd 2012 at the Leech Lake Division of Resource Management when the office opened.
- Matthews said the Lynx weighed 25.8 pounds.

I took photographs of the snare and area the snare was set.
