REPORT

On February 26, 2010 we received a hair sample collected from trap where a suspected lynx had pulled free. Species confirmation and DNA analysis was requested on this specimen.

We were able to obtain quality DNA from this sample for species identification and it is from a lynx. This sample is from a pure lynx (not a lynx-bobcat hybrid), is a male and is a re-capture of a lynx first detected from scat samples collected in 2009 (submitted by Tim Catton); denoted in the database as individual GLNR-S-250.
