OFFICER (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) reports:

On October 27<sup>th</sup>, 2014 at approximately 1600 hours I received a phone call from (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) stating that he found what appeared to him as a dead bobcat along 21<sup>st</sup> St and 3<sup>rd</sup> Ave W in International Falls, MN. I arrived at the scene at approximately 1615 hours where I located the animal and it was identified as a lynx. It appeared that the lynx was possibly struck by a vehicle, as there was no physical damage to the animal or other injuries which would indicate any other cause of death and the location where the animal was located was close proximity to a main highway (MN Hwy 53). The lynx was seized and Custody/Seizure Tag # 433089 was filled out. The location of the lynx was not within the Lynx Management Zone.

The lynx is in the process of being pelted and then will be transferred to the Littlefork/Big Falls Public School District 362 for educational purposes and the carcass will be turned over to DNR Wildlife staff.

OFFICER (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) reports:

On December 27<sup>th</sup>, 2014 at approximately 1400 hours I received a voice mail from (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) stating that he had incidentally caught a lynx in a coyote snare. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) stated that he had removed the animal from the snare and site as he didn't want the animal to spoil with the unseasonably warm weather at the time. I contacted (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) later that evening and told him I would be pick-up the lynx at his residence.

At approximately 1830 hours I arrived at (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) residence, (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) is a lifelong trapper and was upset and disappointed that he had incidentally captured the lynx. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) stated that he and his son were coyote snaring during the time of the capture. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) stated that the lynx was captured around the rear torso area and was deceased upon arriving at the snare site. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) stated that they were using a deer carcass for bait and several snares were placed in close proximity of the deer carcass. The incidental capture site was outside the Lynx Management Zone. Know further investigation into the incidental capture was warranted as everything stated by (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) was legal according to Minnesota trapping regulations.

Custody/Seizure # 437796 was filled out for the lynx, the animal was pelted at which time will be retained by Enforcement Division for educational purposes and the carcass was turned over to DNR Wildlife staff.

OFFICER (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) reports:

On 12/29/14, Conservation Officer (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) received a phone call from (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) (DOB (b) (6), (b) (7)(C)) (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) stated that he was checking his traps on the Lund Forest Road and had caught a lynx incidentally in his snare. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) stated he did not remove the lynx and once he confirmed it was a lynx he immediately contacted CO (b) (6), (b) (7)(C).

At approximately 1500 hours, Conservation Officer (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) and I arrived at the snare's location on the Lund Forest Road approximately a quarter mile down the road. While approaching the snare, I noticed the lynx had the snare loop around the rear portion of the abdomen just in front of the hind legs and was deceased.

Upon further investigation, both CO (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) and I confirmed that the snare set was a legal set according to Minnesota Trapping Regulations. Based on my observations, I determined that (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) snare had no intention of targeting lynx. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) snare was not located in the lynx management zone and he was instructed to notify an officer if he had another incidental catch.

I seized the lynx with Custody/Seizure Tag #433001 and retained the fur for division use and educational purposes.
