Phil.

1/16 is correct. At release site, I found a piece of cable that had been cut from snare which held lynx. I collected it. Diameter of that cable matched diameter of snare cable that I use. Thus, that's what I used as a reference to make this determination. I'll double check this by comparing to 5/64 when I get a chance. Or, I can mail a piece of the cable that I collected if that's necessary.
