Per recent emails and communication with Jess Carey it is clear he is unhappy with the project. In his email he states certain expectations from us because of Catron County being on the MOU. Can you clarify what we as the FWS are required to share with Catron Country per the MOU? I think we as a team need to have a clear understanding about this and then decide on a plan going forward on how we share data with Jess. For example, do we share the flightsheet with Jess? Can we set a schedule where an IFTL sends him updated flighsheets? What is the expectation in regards to sharing depredation assignments? How does NMGFD want to share this information since they are the lead on depredations? Finally, when do we share and when do we not share location data with Jess? We have agreed in the past not to share location data prior to an investigation because it has swayed determinations in the past, but can we put that in writing somewhere?
