Per our phone conversation this morning, here are photos of the latest wolf visit (plus history). I also notified (b) (6) (Magdalena) via phone call and Justin

Martens (US F&W) via voice mail, and Jess Carey of Catron County via email.

Our night vision cameras recorded the wolf at the barn last night, but did not record him leaving the barn area. It appears the wolf may be sleeping in the hay in our barn.

Per May 4, 2015, voice mail received from Justin Martens (US F&W): He will be here tonight and tomorrow night from 8:30 p.m. to 12:30 a.m. to haze the wolf (May 5 and May 6, 2015).
