I have requested on several occasion that I be put on the email list when sending wolf depredation assignments for confirmed and probable depredation conformations. Right now I am 6 reports behind waiting for the depredation wolf assignments; reports dates, 10-10-2021, 10-11-2021, 10-26-2021, 11-04-2021, 11-06-2021, and 11-10-2021. Other reports I sent out without the depredation assignments.

This problem really put me behind in report completion and I am not very happy about this problem. The Catron County Commission signed the MOU with the USFWS so the County would get better information etc. Well, I for one can say this is not true at all. The County is still treated the same as before the MOU was signed.

When you re-collar wolves, why is the county not notified to have the ground telemetry receiver upgraded or the frequencies given for update. This is also an ongoing problem.
