They are concerned about the large scale change in land use type and the potential for T&E species dispersal onto their property increasing their regulatory burden. In the Service's June 25, 2019 letter to the Miccosukee/Chairman Cypress, we included a paragraph near the end saying that the Service had received a FOIA request, that the Service was "currently determining which documentation is responsive", and that the Miccosukee Tribe's April 2, 2019 letter may not be exempt from the FOIA request. And it is not exempt, (I checked) because it does not involve privileged information related to historic properties.

The Seminole comments would similarly not be exempt from FOIA, unless they refer to such information as the locations of archaeological sites.

Please let me know if you need additional information about FOIA and Tribes.

A "lesson learned" from this (for me, anyway) is that it will be beneficial in the future, when inviting Tribes to comment/consult, that the Service inform the Tribes that their written correspondences may be subject to FOIA (unless they are related to the locations of historic properties/cultural resources).

SUBJECT: Eastern Collier Multiple Species Habitat Conservation Plan – Environmental Impact Statement Scoping and Input on Draft Plan

Dear Mr. McDonald:

The Miccosukee Tribe of Indians of Florida is a federally-recognized and federally-protected Indian Tribe, whose members live and work within the Florida Everglades, whose land interests lie within the Florida Everglades, and whose cultural identity and way of life is dependent upon maintaining the natural Everglades. The Tribe exercises powers of self-governance under a Tribal constitution approved by the Secretary of Interior, pursuant to the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934, 25 U.S.C.§ 476. The term "Everglades" as used herein refers to the areas presently identified as the Florida Water Conservation Areas (WCA) and Everglades National Park (ENP), although the Everglades ecosystem historically included a much larger area. The entire Miccosukee way of life, including their cultural, religious, economic, and historical identity, is based upon the Everglades and upon the preservation of the Everglades in its natural state. The Tribe and its members rely upon the Everglades in its natural state to support both subsistence and commercial activities. Subsistence activities include gathering of materials, hunting, and fishing within the Everglades. Commercial activities include frogging, airboat and other guided tours, and recreational and tourism facilities within the Everglades.

The Miccosukee Tribe of Indians of Florida formally rejects the Eastern Collier County Multiple Species Habitat Conservation Plan (HCP), the associated incidental take permit applications, and the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service's (Service) Draft Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) on

the HCP dated September, 2018. The Tribe vehemently urges the Service to deny the HCP and applications accordingly. The proposed project violates the Miccosukee Tribe of Indians of Florida ("Tribe") rights under existing federal law that protects the Tribe's sovereignty, culture and ceremonial practices. The entire proposed area is rich in Miccosukee cultural, historical and archeological resources. In addition, the proposed housing development and infrastructure will only add an additional roadblock and exacerbate the ongoing impediments related to the greater Everglades Restoration. Not only will this affect the panther and other listed species but all animals will have less suitable habitat, connectivity between populations, and human-animal conflict will dramatically increase. The HCP will also reduce the likelihood of the survival and recovery of listed species within the proposed area.

OBJECTIONS:

The Miccosukee Tribe of Indians of Florida rejects the HCP and the application for incidental take of endangered species. The addition of housing developments and related infrastructure only exacerbates the problem of less suitable habitat, connectivity between populations, and the potential for human-animal conflict. As Florida panthers are pushed further out of the proposed HCP area, populations have nowhere to move but further inland toward the Miccosukee and Big Cypress Reservations. The HCP and its adjoining Incidental Take Permit (ITP) are fraught with loopholes and latitude for corruption of data creating potential for less than optimal land management practices and decisions made on personal gain, and not for the betterment of the critical habitat or for the panther and other protected species.

Cultural Resources: The cultural resources are not adequately addressed in the HCP and EIS and the requirement for consultation is not addressed at all. The cultural resources of the Tribe are of the utmost importance and are sacred to the Miccosukee people. It is very concerning to the Tribe that mandated consultation with the Miccosukee people was not even contemplated by the Service until after the Miccosukee received notice from other parties and contacted the Service to engage in government-to-government consultation. Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act requires federal agencies to consult with federally recognized Native American Tribes to identify cultural resources of concern. The Miccosukee Tribe of Indians of Florida is a federally-recognized and federally-protected Indian Tribe within the meaning of that federal law. In addition, the Service must comply with NEPA when making decision whether to issue a permit. NEPA compliance cannot be achieved without consultation with the Tribe.

Comment on the HCP/ITP: The HCP/ITP applications are filled with loopholes, and abilities for contractors, land owners, and stakeholders to be dishonest about their land practices and data gathering. Scientific monitoring, and government oversight have the potential for corruption which leads to mismanagement and manipulation of data for a desired outcome. Designation of "best management practices" and other forms of conservation such as exotic plant abatement have yet to be determined with this HCP/ITP and remains undefined. The document provides that the HCP will require land owners to hire their own research scientists or form their own research departments to do all the monitoring before, during, and after projects. "Each permittee will be responsible for ensuring that compliance monitoring is conducted and reported in accordance with the permittee's ITP." This proposed self- compliance leaves room for corruption and mismanagement of data. Each permittee should be monitored by an independent

contractor who will not be influenced by the permittee. Sales of properties like Half Circle L Ranch within the HCP area do not entirely address the conditions of sale for various properties. Nothing in the proposed ITP provides that any subsequent land purchaser/holder or grantee will be subject to the conditions of the HCP/ITP.

Continuing with the document's vague proposals, the HCP claims that "some habitat loss will occur in connection with the Covered Activities, but under the Plan, habitat loss will be minimized..." The Miccosukee propose that the HCP/ITP first establish a maximum amount of habitat loss before these projects commence, and provide further that if they exceed a certain threshold through intentional, unintentional, or by accidental destruction, work must immediately halt, further consultation take place on the matter and mitigation occur to minimize the damage from the loss of habitat.

The HCP also claims that "...the interest of the applicants avoiding native habitat impacts..." is justification to move forward with the project, and should be considered "good faith" of the land owners and stakeholders to comply with the requirements of the HCP. Any good faith placed on a land owner is not a guarantee that the average land owner is going to comply with anything that the HCP sets forth as a requirement. Additionally, there is no guarantee of any ability to levy taxes on land owners within the HCP.

Biologically speaking, the HCP projects in the Covered Activities area an increased strain between the human-animal interface. The potential for man to interact with a wild cat in their backyard greatly increases, and further adds to the possibility of panther termination (reported or non-reported), as well as injury or possible death to people in these transitional ecological zones. There are already two major options for panthers in these areas: urban sprawl putting pressure on panthers to move further out and away from these urban centers, or in the cases of habitat degradation and food scarcity, panthers may have the potential to start roaming urban areas looking for food or a eating a family pet or more devastating, attack a small human.

The Florida panther recovery plan calls for increased habitat and populations, not substantial decrease in habitat as outlined in the HCP. It is untenable if the Service finds that the HCP, which proposes to destroy 45,000 acres, will not result in the jeopardy for panthers. The loss of habitat coupled with the already scarce breeding habitat will prove impossible to maintain a viable panther population in southern Florida. It is clear that the proposal to "offset" the impact of destroying a *substantial* amount of panther breeding habitat cannot be achieved by merely refraining from destroying other habitat.

Mitigation projects such as habitat restoration, habitat connectivity, and road projects like animal by-passes over or under roads are untenable solutions in this HCP. Existing habitat in corridors on the west side of the HCP south of Oil Well Rd—for example—lack the space and habitat complexity for ease of travel for panthers to the north from the reserve to the south. Much of this land is plowed farm fields, and levy roads flanking strips of cypress swamp and other habitat types that are detrimental to panther habitat complexity and access. These strips of habitat are further bisected by roads such as Oil Well Rd with minimal access to the other side. It is evident in the proposed projects in the HCP do not consider nor coincide with the Florida Department of Transportation. Road projects. Due to the critical nature of this project and the HCP, all affected

departments and stakeholders must integrate their plans to guard against hundreds of panthers dying annually on roads like State Route 29. A comprehensive resolution must be identified to insure safe passage at the locations where the animals already cross these roadways, and a proper warning sensor systems and animal over or under passes are in place.

The Miccosukee find it troublesome that not enough emphasis of importance has been placed on cultural considerations due to the amount of historical and anthropological sites within the footprint of the HCP. The identification and preservation of cultural sites is of great import to the Miccosukee people. The HCP must place a high priority on locating and preserving these sites. The Miccosukee note that on page 47, of the 32 listed archeological sites in table 3.5.2, 46% of them have yet to be evaluated, and 28% have little to no information with which to make a proper assessment as to their designation. It is by this assessment of the available record that the Miccosukee feel a determination cannot be made in order to proceed with the HCP/ITP as it pertains to the anthropological sensitivity of the land.

ADDITIONAL QUESTIONS:

The Miccosukee have several unanswered questions. Those questions are as follows:

- 1. Does incidental take account for resident take? Residents killing endangered species either knowingly or unknowingly?
- 2. Is there a threshold of measurable "take," and can the ITP be revoked?
- 3. "Maintenance of lands designated as preservation and very low density use, to preserve ecological value of those lands for covered species, through land management practices such as control of invasive species." Who's responsibility will this be?
- 4. Pg 31. "Construction and maintenance of surface water management structures for preservation or enhancement of existing or natural hydrologic function." What does this construction entail? Who will be monitoring and decision making on flow regulation?
- 5. "Construction of fenced wildlife crossings to ensure safe passage of panthers..." If underpasses or overpasses are not feasible, funneling fence lines with Large Animal Warning and Detection Systems (LAWDS), would be recommended. These motion sensors at crossings alert vehicles to slow or even stop when red/yellow lights flash at the crossing.
- 6. Who's keeping the landowners accountable?
- 7. The document reflects very little about actual habitat restoration. Are there key sites identified and if not, and are you taking recommendations?
- 8. Riparian corridors should be stressed with the greatest importance, and restoration of crop land within these zones should be restored to increase pass ability through these corridors.
- 9. Connectivity for panthers and width of corridors should be considered. Oil Well Rd (858) at the west edge of the HCP has suboptimal connectivity, mostly due to agriculture presence to the south of the road.
- 10. Won't the taxes that will be levied on home and property sales have to be brought before the state of Florida legislature for a vote, and therefore is not a guarantee?

11. Page 228 – Can this area be used as a tortoise relocation place?

Comments for EIS/ITP -

- 1. Pg. 109 Highway widening along the 29 corridor from Alligator Alley into Immokalee. Concern for increased traffic, increased panther-vehicle mortality, and very little collaboration between various departments at the state level (FDOT), and the entities involved in mitigation of the HCP.
- 2. Pg 129 The HCP document mentions that the Half Circle L Ranch is currently for sale with no mention of bidders. The EIS/ITP document mentions that Florida Forever—a state run property acquisition group—is trying to acquire the property. Since this project is ranked 8 out of about 130 projects, it has a high potential for purchase (according to verbal communication with Florida Forever), but the HCP doesn't mention this potential plan.

CONCLUSION:

The Miccosukee Tribe of Indians of Florida offers these statements, comments and objections for your review. We are most concerned about the lack of adequate archeological protection especially in regards our sacred places. Additionally, the HCP will also reduce the likelihood of the survival and recovery of listed species within the proposed area. The Tribe vehemently opposes this HCP and any ITP requests and urges the Service to not authorize the take of any of these species (northern crested caracara, eastern indigo snake, and Florida panther Florida bonneted bat) as proposed in the HCP.

This tribe, like all other tribes throughout the United States, remain the last defense of the environment. This Miccosukee hope that the US Fish and Wildlife Service will take up the defense to continue to protect all animals and their habitat for years to come and for future generations. We have endeavored to meet with the US Fish & Wildlife Service but other than a brief teleconference where many of the individuals within the Service were either absent or not invited to attend, any meaningful consultation on this important matter has yet to take place.




