Hi Rich - Our status review is in the final stages of internal review and one of my colleagues asked a question about the map that John Guinotte prepared and sent to you earlier (*attached here again*).

On that map, there is no harvest information in the Canadian Cascades region of BC. Do you have any trapping information from this region? Particularly within 110 km of the U.S.-Canada border? Do you have similar information for the Selkirk Mountains in BC?

Also, following-up on our previous email discussion (sent by me on Aug 2), in which we asked about the management unit in which 25 individuals were taken. Do you have any wolverine population information for this unit, or for this region?
