Hello Betty,

We have 5 records for the 4 years 2013-2016. Did not include 2017 due to trapping season has not started. No records at all for 2017 yet. The five records include 3 incidentals and 2 road/rail kills.

The incidentals were:

1/7/14 – dead in foothold trap

12/17/14 – dead in snare

12/22/14 – dead in conibear trap

The roadkills were:

2/3/15 – Sanders County

[3/19/15](#) – [Hwy 200](#) near Plains, MT

I also found an additional record by learning how to sort through the database in a different way. This was a wolverine captured in a foot hold trap and released uninjured on 12/18/2013.
