Hi Bob - The map provided in your agency's technical comments to the SSA Report is labeled "**Preliminary Field Results Winter 2016-2017 Wolverine Detections.**" In their comment letter, WY F&G stated that this map is for both the 2015-2016 (Wyoming only) winter and 2016-2017 (four States).
