Summary

Non-telemetry verifiable detections of wolverines in Washington since 2000 (updated 21 December 2016 by Catherine Raley).

Description

This database was compiled by Keith Aubry (Emeritus Scientist; kaubry@fs.fed.us) and Catherine Raley (Wildlife Biologist; craley@fs.fed.us); USDA Forest Service, Pacific Northwest Research Station, Olympia, WA. The information in this database (updated 21 December 2016) represents, as far as we know, a comprehensive account of non-telemetry verifiable detections of wolverines in Washington since 2000. The following verifiable wolverine records were obtained from camera surveys conducted by various government and non-government organizations, opportunistic photographs obtained by private citizens, and initial capture locations of wolverines monitored during the North Cascades Wolverine Study (NCWS; USDA Forest Service). Locality names are unique and each row represents all the verifiable wolverine detections at a given locality during the specified year.
