Hi Justin,

Getting back to you with the rough game plan on our end re the snow model schedule. Steve and I have two in person meetings planned in Boulder with NOAA/CU. (Wed, Jan 18 and Thurs, Feb 2). We have no results to work with at present and we don't expect to have any future snow pack projection results from them until mid Feb. They told us they didn't expect to have results to show us on Feb 2 when we meet.

Current status: NOAA/CU are trying to rectify a (present day) offset issue between what their snow model is producing and what snotel station data on the ground is reporting in Glacier and RMNP. Once this is overcome they will begin projecting forward in time and giving us outputs.

I passed all relevant GIS files/data re wolverine habitat and occurrence to Ed Turner on Monday so he has what I have. I also told him I'd be happy to talk to him and/or help in any way I can.

Feel free to give me a ring if you want to discuss. I'm back in the office.
